

How Wealthy is NY? See Every County Ranked by Income

Nassau County on Long Island had the highest median household income in New York, according to the most recent census data available.

The county had a median household income of over \$143,000 a year, according to five-year census estimates from 2023. That was the highest total in the state by more than \$14,000.

No. 2 statewide was Suffolk County at over \$128,000.

The top six wealthiest counties in the state all had median household incomes of more than \$100,000, according to the 2023 data.

They also included: Putnam, Westchester, Rockland and New York (Manhattan) counties.

Among the four big Upstate New York counties, Albany had the highest income at over \$83,000, according to the census data. That ranked No. 14 statewide.

Onondaga County and Monroe County were next, both with median household incomes of over \$74,000. Onondaga ranked 20th statewide and Monroe was 21st.

Erie County had median household income of about \$71,000, according to the 2023 census data. That ranked 31st statewide.

Bronx County in New York City had the lowest median household income statewide at about \$49,000. It was the only county in the state with a household income under \$50,000 a year.
