16-17 Year Old Vaccinations (Phase 3):

- Register on VINI at <https://www.vaccines.nh.gov/>.
- Locations that will have Pfizer vaccine: All state-managed fixed sites and Walgreens, as well as North Country Health, Littleton Regional, Huggins, Memorial, LRG Hospitals.
- Parents or guardians must accompany and have ID to prove NH residency.
- Bring driver's license or non-driver's ID with birth certificate or passport.

NH Immunization Information System (NHIIS)

To be re-opened on April 15th, NHIIS will feature:

- Consolidated Records for patients
- Management of Vaccine Inventory
- Forecast Immunizations
- Reminder/Recall features
- Expedited Response in an Outbreak
- New look and feel, with streamlined navigation and enhanced reports

Transferring April 1-15 from VaxNH to new NHIIS

- The **current IIS/VOMS (VaxNH) will sunset on April 1, 2021**. All user and provider information to be transferred from the legacy IIS to NHIIS.
- **Vaccine orders will be suspended from April 1 until NHIIS launched on April 15, 2021.** Plan to have at least a 4 to 6-week supply of vaccine ordered by April 1.
- Provisions will be made on a case by case basis for **emergency ordering** via fax to NHIP.
- **COVID-19 Vaccine orders moved to NHIIS from VAMS. You will be placing orders, create internal transfer between clinics and reconcile within NHIIS only.**

How do I get trained to use NHIIS?

- NHIIS training will consist of 30 minute web-based training module followed by a structural quiz. Successfully completing the quiz will provide you with a certificate that you need to Email/fax to NHIP.
- All existing users must take the training and pass the quiz successfully to get access to NHIIS. NHIIS will have a new look, improved features, and enhancements that will be reviewed during the training session.
- This training is ongoing for existing VaxNH/NHIIS users, and registration will be available on the new NHIIS Training webpage this week.

Transitioning from Public to Private COVID-19 Vaccine Allocation Process in NH

- 1) Vaccine supply and Phase 3 numbers driving allocation process shift
- 2) NH-DHHS survey sent last week
- 3) Next week – All pharmacies (expanded federal program)
- 4) Next 2-3 weeks – Private **Public POD** expansion
- 5) Next 3-5 weeks – Private **Closed POD** expansion
- 6) **Next Tuesday Alliance Call** – DHHS Outline of COVID-19 Allocation Transition

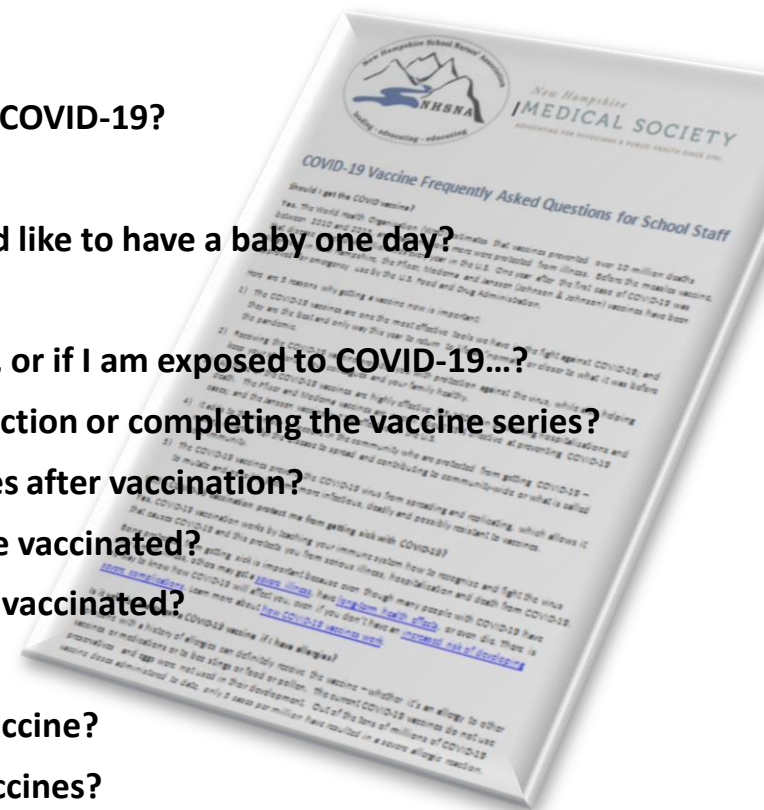
Begin Preparing for Vaccine Allocation Transition

- 2) Review design of Workflows (NH Vaccine Information & CDC Websites)
- 3) Develop COVID-19 Vaccine FAQs & Information
- 4) COVID-19 Vaccine Messaging & Promotion

- 1) Should I get the COVID vaccine?
- 2) Will a COVID-19 vaccination protect me from getting sick with COVID-19?
- 3) Is it safe for me to get a COVID-19 vaccine if I have allergies?
- 4) Are COVID-19 vaccines safe if I am pregnant, lactating or would like to have a baby one day?
- 5) What side effects are possible after vaccination?
- 6) Do I still need to quarantine for travel outside of New England, or if I am exposed to COVID-19...?
- 7) What if I develop symptoms after having a prior COVID-19 infection or completing the vaccine series?
- 8) Will I still need to wear a mask and follow prevention measures after vaccination?
- 9) If I tested positive for COVID-19 in the past, do I still need to be vaccinated?
- 10) If I currently have COVID-19, how long do I need to wait to get vaccinated?
- 11) If I get the vaccine, will I test positive for COVID-19?
- 12) Will I have to get vaccinated every year like I do with the flu vaccine?
- 13) Where can I find more information regarding the COVID-19 vaccines?
