

Promoting Health and Safety

Best-Practice guidelines on promoting health and safety will be communicated in a variety of ways: pre-camp email and website posts, onsite signage, and in welcome packets. These practices include:

- Wash hands with soap and water for twenty seconds and wash often.
- Practice physical distancing between households, other guests, and staff. (6')
- Show special care to older adults and people with severe underlying conditions (e.g. heart, lung, diabetes).
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover coughs and sneezes.
- Avoid sharing personal items and foods outside your household unit.
- Wearing a mask is not required. However, masks are encouraged in high traffic areas.
- Staff will follow workplace guidelines, including all staff being screen for symptoms of Covid-19 every day.
- Prescreening questions will be sent to guests prior to their stay; guests will be screened on site, and sent a post health survey.

Food Service:

Camp will not provide food service this summer.

Households will need to bring supplies to prepare and cook their own meals at campsites and cabins.

Dogs:

- are welcome in campgrounds and at cabins (outdoors).
- will be kenneled or leashed at all times.
- will be personally attended at all times (do not leave at campsite or cabin).
- are not allowed inside buildings (exception: registered service animal).
- waste must be bagged up and disposed of properly.

Vehicles:

- Speed Limit is **10mph**.
- Passengers will be inside vehicles (truck beds, running boards, trailers, etc. are not allowed).

Golf Carts:

- No golf carts are allowed on site.
- Guests with mobility issues - please call camp for approval.

Housekeeping

Lake Beauty's housekeeping and facilities teams plan to follow the guidelines outlined in the **MNDH Lodging Establishment Cleaning Guidance for COVID-19** (4/15/20). In addition, Camp will employ:

1. Cleaning
 - All private housing units and restrooms will be thoroughly cleaned between sessions with all common touch points disinfected.
 - All public restrooms will be cleaned twice per day while guests are on site. During these cleanings all public area touch points will be disinfected.
 - All common spaces that are reserved and used by a guest will be cleaned and disinfected between uses.
2. Linens
 - For the safety of Camp guests and staff we will require guests to supply their own bedding and towels.
