- All these efforts are setting the stage for a September start to an official search to fill the Executive Director position. At its September 9-10 meeting, I anticipate that the board will review the preparations, identify a search team, and officially initiate the posting of the position. We trust that these Spirit-led efforts will bring the next Executive Director to Lake Beauty during the fourth quarter of 2022.
- We are also beginning to plan for the LBBC Annual Meeting of delegates on October 29, 2022.
