WHAT WE DO: We award more than \$45,000/year to local non-profits serving the youth of Allegan County, we perform community service projects, and we award an annual scholarship to an Allegan County student who has put an emphasis on community service.

WHAT IS A CLASSROOM MINI-GRANT? A mini-grant is a request to the TAG Team by teachers in Allegan County schools who need additional funds for their classroom.

WHAT CAN I APPLY FOR? Pens, pencils, paper, crayons, posters, flash cards, tissues, scissors, or any other classroom item that helps you and your kids!

4. 15 - 20 classroom grants of \$100 each will be selected at random.
