POLICY UPDATE

Graduate Reinstatement is for graduate students who have not registered and enrolled for a minimum of six (6) credits in a 12-month period and are now considered to be non-degree seeking students. If the student has not exceeded their time limit for degree completion, they may apply for reinstatement by completing the Graduate Major Reinstatement Form, including the FL Residency form, and Prior Conduct Form.

ETD AND WRITING SERVICES

Electronic Thesis and Dissertation (ETD) information:

Deadlines:

March 13	Thesis Deadline to submit to OGS for review
March 27	Dissertation Deadline to submit to OGS for review
May 1	Last day to submit Admission to Candidacy Form to OGS
May 7	ETD Final Clearance – last day to receive OGS final approval

- **ETD Process:** Submission and resource guide.
- **ETD Process Workshop:** January 28th at Noon
- **ETD Weekly Formatting Workshop:** Avoid processing delays and formatting errors by attending!

Students: A template, Example Pages, and guide videos are available to help you! Set up your format early in your writing process to save time. Also check with your Dept or College for additional requirements.

Faculty: *Make sure your students know in advance that USF has Institutional Guidelines for [ETD formatting](#)! Note: Students who are unaware of the formatting guidelines are more likely to be charged an extra [fee](#).*
