Friday, March 31st (virtual) and April 1st (in-person)

Symposium Theme:

**Groundbreaking Approaches for Qualitative Research Design,
Presentation, and Publication**

The symposium provides a space where students, faculty, and other participating researchers can engage in scholarly conversations that will contribute towards understanding diverse qualitative methodologies and their applications.

In this two-day hybrid symposium (virtual and in-person), we welcome all types of qualitative research approaches, and we are open to ongoing or completed empirical or theoretical research. We encourage submissions from a wide range of qualitative research representing Education, Communications, Anthropology, Sociology, Women's and Gender Studies, Health, and English, among others.

Submitting your proposal

You may either propose an individual paper (15 minutes), a poster, or a panel (60 minutes). A panel contains four or less brief presentations, and then a discussant provides reactions to each of the brief presentations. Ample time for questions from participants should be provided.
