

Y's Men Spring Golf Outing

Monday, June 9, 2025

Date & Location: Monday, June 9. Longshore Golf Course.

Tee Times: First Tee Time at 10:30 AM

Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$85, payable in cash only at check in. The entry fee includes Green Fees, Cart Rental, Range Balls, Prizes, and appetizers at the "Black Duck".

Scorecards: Please use the Y's Men "**Team Scorecards**" given to you by Bob Leng at check in. Each team is assigned a **Captain** who will be responsible for the scoring and enforcing the rules. At the conclusion of the play, scores are to be tallied, **signed, and attested**.

Posting of Scores: After **the completion of the play, the scorecards shall be turned in at the Pro Shop Desk. Score Cards not submitted will be assumed "withdrawn"**.

Format: Best Ball - "Team Scramble"

All four team members tee off on each hole. After teeing off, the team selects the best tee shot and that ball is marked. All players can hit subsequent shots with the best ball selected after each group of shots. For teams with 3 players, each player will take turns to make the fourth shot. That rotation should be established on the 1st tee.

Par 3 holes are included as driving holes. Each player must have at least 4 drives selected during the round. The same rule applies for teams of 3 players.

All players are to putt, and no putts can be conceded.

Area under repair allows for a free drop outside the hazard.

The team score for each hole should be recorded on the **Y's Men Scorecard - Team Score** line of the official scorecard provided at check in. **This scorecard should be turned in at the Pro Shop at the end of the Round.**

Tees: Play will be from the **White** tee markers. **Players over 80 years of age may play from the Yellow Tee, 90s may play from the Orange Tee.**

Prizes:

Low Team Gross

the lowest total Team score without adjustment. In the event of a tie for the lowest team gross score, the winning team will be decided by the best score for the last nine holes, the last six holes, the last three holes and finally the 18th hole. If this formula fails to produce a winner, the same formula will be applied to the first nine holes.

Closest to the Pin on #8 (No ties)

Closest to the Line on #7 (No ties)

Closest to the Pin on #15 (No ties)

Longest Drive on #16 (No ties)

Winners will be announced at the Black Duck (about 4:30 PM). Winners will also be announced by email (to all participants) and will be posted in the Golf Activities Section on the Y's Men Website. Prizes will be redeemed at the Pro Shop.

Range Balls: Jon Janik, the Longshore Pro, is providing complimentary Range Balls for all participants.

Governing Rules: The rules of the United States Golf Association ("USGA") and the Longshore Men's Golf Association ("LGMA") Local Rules shall govern all play.

Course Etiquette: Please take responsibility to ensure that divots are replaced, bunkers are raked, and ball marks on the greens are properly repaired.

Informal Gathering at The Black Duck: Immediately after the round, an informal gathering will take place at the Black Duck starting at 3:30 PM. The Black Duck will provide appetizers and there will be a cash bar. **And you must pay for any additional order of food that you might place. Please tip the waitress individually for drinks that you order and please leave a tip for the event.**
