

CHEESY MASHED POTATO BITES

yield: 6 SERVINGS

prep time: 5 MINUTES

cook time: 20 MINUTES

Ingredients

- 2 cups mashed potatoes (a great way to use leftovers!)
- 3 eggs
- 1/2 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- 1/2 cup steamed broccoli
- salt and pepper to taste
- non-stick cooking spray

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 400°F.
2. Spray muffin tin with non-stick cooking spray.
3. In a bowl, combine mashed potatoes, eggs, and cheese.
4. Gently stir in steamed broccoli. *To steam broccoli, place in a microwave-safe bowl, add 2-3 tablespoons water, cover. Microwave for 2-3 minutes, or until softened and bright green.*
5. Add salt and pepper if needed.
6. Divide mixture into 6 muffin tins for large bites, or 12 for smaller potato bites. Use mini muffin tin if desired.
7. Bake at 400°F for 20 minutes.
8. Serve immediately or freeze for later.
