Final Exams - Same as Semester 1

Pandemic-related Grade Options for Semester 2 (Same as Semester 1)

Earned Grade (A-F)	Incomplete (IC)	No Grade (NG)
<p>The student has earned a letter grade based on their work throughout the semester.</p> <p>This includes a (F)ailing grade. A failing grade can be recorded only when the student fails to demonstrate academic proficiency after receiving robust academic intervention. This will have a negative impact on the students GPA.</p>	<p>The student is missing a few core assignments and/or assessments that need to be completed in order to determine any academic grade.</p> <p>The teacher is responsible for communicating the assignments that the student MUST complete in order to earn credit for the class.</p> <p>Students may use the summer to complete the work assigned from Semester 2. Teachers will assess the work and assign a grade at the beginning of the school year.</p>	<p>The student has not completed enough work to determine if the student has demonstrated basic proficiency and/or has experienced a significant hardship. Students will not receive credit for this class.</p> <p>Seniors will be assigned an Edgenuity course to earn credit for courses needed for graduation.</p> <p>Students in grades 9 through 11 will be given a summer opportunity for credit recovery or allowed to retake the course without GPA penalty during a future semester.</p>
