Any topic related to international legal issues is acceptable, but we would like to include articles related to the following topics:

1. Issues related to immigration, particularly those relevant to changes that have recently occurred and will likely occur in the future related to control of COVID-19.
2. Trade regulation and treaties, including the impact on current trade matters related to the economic impact of countries responding to COVID-19 and shortages in certain consumer and manufacturing goods.
3. Healthcare regulations as they relate to cross-border business including the laws related to trade in medical equipment, protective equipment, and pharmaceuticals.
4. Energy regulations related to agreements between oil producing countries to limit production and interruptions in continued trade for oil and gas in a time of falling demand and over supply.
5. Impact of possible regulations on political and policy matters that may result from efforts by countries to recover from the health and economic impact of COVID-19.
6. The status of international contracts in a time of major upsets in international business.
7. International human rights issues including matters related to the impact of governmental efforts to control movement of people, exchange of information, and relations among different races and national origins.

Please consider writing an article or asking your colleagues to give it some consideration. The deadline for the submission of articles for the sixth issue is Thursday, **June 4, 2020**.

All articles submitted should:

1. Be between 500 to 2,500 words, although longer copy may be considered;
2. Be submitted in MS Word format and double spaced;
3. Acknowledge all sources, but keep endnotes to a minimum (use numbers not numerals);
4. Include your name, email address, firm/company affiliation and city;
5. Include a brief synopsis of the article of no more than 50 words;
6. Include a short "about the author" summary about you and your practice; and
7. Provide an image suggestion using key words or topical direction.
