There were 557 children that were removed from their homes due to abuse, neglect, and/or abandonment.

## Permanency for Children

581 children exited out-of-home care through reunification, closed permanent guardianship or adoption.

## Licensed Foster Homes

Heartland for Children had 36 new foster homes licensed during this year.

243 children were reunified with their families! This was the result for 41.8% of children who exited out-of-home care.

## New Case Managers

There were 58 new case managers hired and completed training this year and there was a higher retention rate of case managers than in recent years.

146 children's cases closed under Permanent Guardianship. This was the result for 25.1% of children who exited out-of-home care.
