



JESUS CALMED THE STORM

One evening after Jesus taught a large crowd of people, He told His disciples, "Let's cross to the other side of the sea." They got into the boat and set sail.

As they were sailing, Jesus fell asleep on a cushion in the back of the boat. Suddenly, strong winds began to blow the boat back and forth. Huge waves crashed into the boat, and water splashed all around them. The bottom of the boat was filling with water. The disciples were scared! The disciples woke Jesus and asked, "Don't You care that we're about to die?"

Then Jesus got up and said to the wind and the waves, "Silence! Be still!" The wind stopped blowing, and the waves stopped crashing. Everything was calm on the sea. Jesus asked the disciples why they were so afraid. He asked, "Do you still have no faith?"

The disciples did not know what to think. They were scared. They asked each other, "Who is this man? Even the wind and water obey Him!"
