Sermon: "Counter-Culture Charter"

Text: Romans 12:9-21

St. Paul has, throughout his letter to the Romans, clearly articulated that the Life of Christ, His perfect life and innocent sacrifice of the same, has saved our lives! As he concluded his letter Paul turned his attention to the response of lives so delivered: "Love sincerely. Cling to what is good. Honor others above yourself." (Romans 12:9ff)

The depth of his contrition explains the height of his elation and the breath of his relief as he ponders and embraces the promise of deliverance in the Messiah."

Those words were written by the sainted Rev. Arnie Kuntz. Pastor Kuntz is also the author of our Living Way study this year, the Penitential and Messianic Psalms of David. Pastor Kuntz served as President of the Southern California District and Sr. Pastor of Bethany Lutheran Church, Long Beach. Our FIRST session will be on October 4th. Living Way begins at 7:00PM, following ReFuel worship. We will be doing lesson 1, which is Psalm 6, on October 4th and thus you'll have homework prior to our first session of Living Way.
