Install GCFI receptacles, switches/light fixtures; fix leaky pipes, install low-flow toilets, faucets, shower-heads, and hose nozzles.

Painting – Interior & Exterior:



Includes preparation and lead paint testing, priming, cleaning, furniture moving and draping, and clean up.

Healthy Home – Safety



Measures:

Gas earthquake valve; water heater straps, grab bars/handrails, smoke/carbon monoxide detectors; moisture-proofing & draft sealing.
