Tim and Cheryl Albers hosted the ISM Lenten meal. Through their many contacts with the internationals attending the Thursday evening World View conversation Class, we invited our friends to attend the meal and service. It was with great joy that we had 16 join us for the service.

Some of the visiting scholars will be attending the International Student Ministry In-Depth Bible Seminar in St. Louis in May. Pastor Wieting leads the Bible reading class on Thursday mornings. Through the contacts made in the meals and social activities, we build friendships which allow us to invite these special friends to hear God's word.
