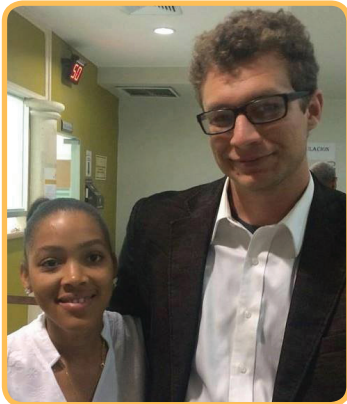

SERVING THE LORD IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC



Tyler McMiller serves the Lord through The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod (LCMS) as a GEO (globally engaged in outreach) missionary in the Dominican Republic. Tyler partners with local church leaders and other LCMS missionaries to strengthen the existing Dominican Republic Lutheran church in Santo Domingo. He assists with the publication of a new Lutheran hymnal for the Spanish-speaking world. He also helps coordinate translation projects of theological material used in developing Hispanic pastors. In addition, Tyler presents workshops with a Christian focus in public and private schools, allowing him to build relationships and invite the students to Church and youth activities.

Tyler was born in Waukesha, Wis., and his home congregations are Elm Grove Evangelical Lutheran Church and School, Elm Grove, Wis., and

Santa Cruz (Holy Cross) Lutheran Church, Racine, Wis. At Santa Cruz Lutheran Church, from 2010-2014, he helped translate sermons, played the violin and taught catechism classes. Being a missionary kid, Tyler lived in Chile and Panama for a number of years. He then earned a bachelor's degree in Spanish and history from Concordia University Wisconsin, Mequon. While in college, Tyler played in a Mexican mariachi band (Mariachi Real Azteca) for four years. He also studied in Chile the spring of 2014, where he voluntarily played the violin at Sunday worship services and translated extensively for the Lutheran Church of Chile (ILC). Tyler enjoys playing the violin and guitar, reading Spanish, studying Greek for seminary, studying history and volunteering at church.

Tyler's wife, Yanela, joins him on the missionary field in the Dominican Republic. She is a teacher and has worked several years at the Lutheran school in Licey, Dominican Republic. When Yanela was 19 years old, she was in the first group of Dominicans to be baptized by the LCMS mission team in this region.

Pray for Tyler as he serves in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic. Ask God to keep him safe as he travels and serves throughout the country. Pray for the sharing of the Gospel and the raising up of leaders in a part of the world that is in great need of Lutheran doctrine and its confession. Pray also that Christ's comfort and assurance of salvation are shared with the Dominicans as the Gospel is proclaimed. Let us give thanks to God that Tyler is serving His children in this part of the world.
