The mission of Crossroads Rhode Island is to help those experiencing homelessness secure stable homes.

Thanks to sponsor and donor support in 2025:



2,800+ women and children accessed housing and housing related programs & services at Crossroads.



639 women and children were provided with emergency shelter.



1,275 women and children secured a new place to call home and an additional **547** women and children maintained their housing.



169 women participated in education and employment services designed to help them achieve financial independence, including **55** critically needed **Certified Nursing Assistant** graduates.
