Research Presentations | Abstracts of all types are welcome: they need not contain formal or finalized work and they may be ideas, hypotheses, or works in progress. Formal abstracts of posters and other presentations given at scientific meetings since November 1, 2018 may be submitted. Abstracts should include text only (i.e. no tables or figures) and should not exceed 2,000 characters (including spaces and punctuation).

Laboratory/Study Overviews | We welcome overviews of the various themes of laboratories and ongoing studies. Abstracts should include text only (i.e. no tables or figures) and should not exceed 2,000 characters (including spaces and punctuation).
