

THE VOICE OF THE SIGN

God has always used, and is still using signs to speak to the earth.

“And it shall come to pass, if they will not believe thee, neither hearken to the voice of the first sign, that they will believe the voice of the latter sign.” Exodus 4:8

(Malachi 3:6, Hebrews 13:8)

Signs follow believers and are sent to confirm the Word of God.

“And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.” – Mark 16:17-18 (KJV)

“Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it.” – Mark 16:20 (NIV)

A “sign” is a token, indication, notice, direction, or warning that contains a specific message. Remember when God sent the rainbow to Noah and his family it was a sign that spoke and said: **“this is the sign of the covenant I have established between me and all life on the earth”** (Genesis 9:17).

It is common to see supernatural signs in the glory realm, because Jesus Christ promised that we would and heaven is full of awesome beauty and wonder. If you read about Ezekiel’s encounters in the heavenlies you will be able to get just a glimpse of this visible glory of God. Mark 16 begins to list some of the signs we will experience as believers, but there are many other signs God will do for us as well (John 20:30, John 14:12). Some supernatural signs that we often experience in the glory realm are the gold and oil signs.
