



## Help with Sound and Livestream

Did you know?:

- We have been livestreaming our Sunday morning services every week since October 2021.
- We have more than 40 people every Sunday morning who watch our service live from a remote location (home, vacation, winter home, etc.).
- Another 200 people or so watch the recordings of our livestreams on YouTube (our Easter service was watched by 1,700 people!).

The livestream team is looking for eight people who would be interested in volunteering one Sunday a month to help produce our livestream. We have two roles we are looking to fill each week:

1. People who are interested in being trained to run the sound board. The team has simplified this job significantly, and we have lots of documentation for the training. The majority of this work is muting and unmuting microphones at appropriate times during the service.
2. People who are interested in being trained to run the video portion of our livestream. The team has developed and documented a process for running the video stream. This role involves using a PC to remotely control four separate cameras, switch between camera positions, and displaying appropriate text for hymns, readings and prayers.

Existing members of the team will continue to participate via training and coaching. All are welcome.
