Please remember to bring socks, as they are required for bowling shoes.

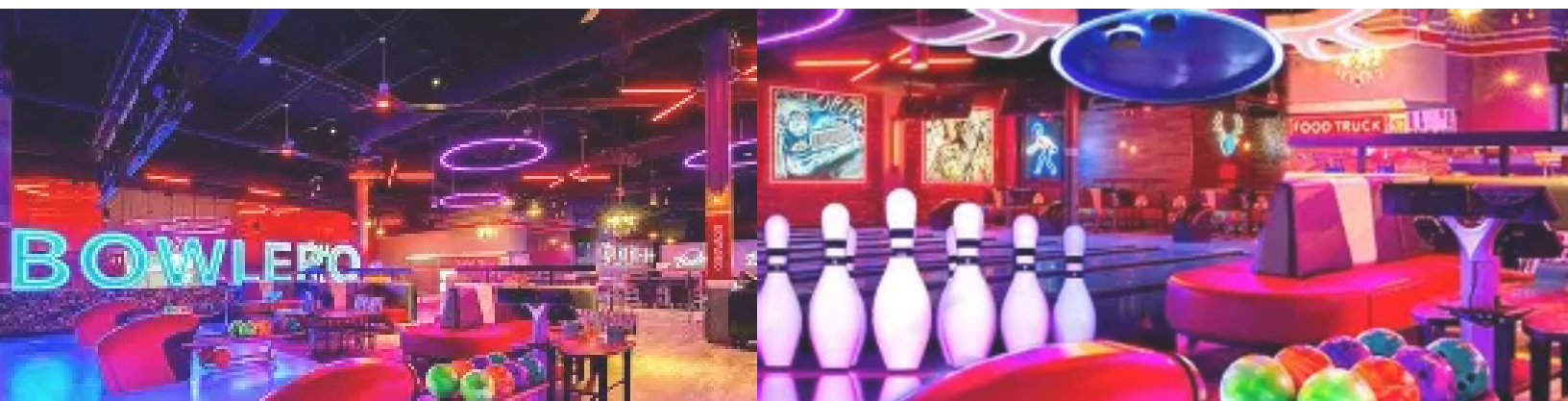
To reserve your spot:

Dix Park Trolls Optional Visit
