This format allows for meaningful discussion, practical strategies, and the opportunity to learn alongside others navigating similar challenges.

The link will remain open until July 1st, and **completing the form is a request for consideration, not a guaranteed placement.**

Every request is important, and the grouping process is not intended to suggest that one need takes precedence over another. Participants will be grouped based on topic area, age/stage, and areas of concern to make the best use of the limited consultation time available.

Since space is limited, and priority *may* be given to those who have not previously participated in a consultation.

- **What makes it different**
 - Instead of first-come, first-served or one-on-one sessions, participants will be thoughtfully grouped by life stage, challenges, and goals to create more meaningful conversations and offer more the opportunity to be coached by Dr. Mooney.
- **HOW IT WORKS!**
 - **1. You must be registered for the TSSUS Conference to be selected.**
 - The link will be open until July 1st and not tied to a specific time or topic, YET
- **During registration, you'll answer questions about:**
 - Your role/life stage
 - Areas you'd like support in
 - What you hope to gain from the session
 - Then, our team will review responses and assign groups accordingly
- **Group size + limited nature**
 - Each session will include a small group of approximately 6–8 participants to allow for meaningful discussion and individualized input.
- **Capacity + selection note**
 - Space is limited. Priority may be given to:
 - Those who have not previously participated in a consultation
 - Those whose needs align most closely with available group topics
