

Nursery Sick Policy

For the health and safety of all children, nursery staff and children's parents, children that have had the following symptoms within the last 24 hours will not be allowed to check into the nursery:

- A known or suspected infectious illness
- A fever within the past 24 hours
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or is feeling unwell
- Cough, sore throat, croup (except in the case of allergy)
- Colored runny noses
- Common Cold
- Contagious skin rash
- Pink eye or other known eye infections
- Lice
- Impetigo (infected wounds), boils, untreated ringworms
- Any symptom of usual childhood disease such as mumps, measles, chicken pox, hand foot and mouth, etc.

If a child has been checked into the nursery and staff/volunteers notice any of these symptoms, parents will be sent a text message through KidCheck to pick up their child from the nursery.

The nursery staff and volunteers will <u>NOT</u> administer any form of medication to children checked into the nursery.
