## THE HARDY GALLERY CALL FOR ARTISTS: The Community Mosaic Project

The popular Community Mosaic Project is celebrating its 19th year this exhibition season! This project consists of over 300 individual 6"x6" works of art from artists of all ages and backgrounds, and is the Hardy's most engaging community-driven program! The Community Mosaic is on display at the same time as the Collection Invitational, and you are able to purchase one of the canvases through a blind mailing; all proceeds benefit the nonprofit organization and its efforts in supporting local Door County artists. All canvases have been generously supplied by Artists Guild LLC in Sturgeon Bay.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Canvases are currently available for pickup at Artists Guild. Additional canvases will be available for pickup at the Hardy Gallery once open for the season, beginning at our first reception of 2026, for the 64th Annual Wall-To-Wall Juried Exhibit, May 22, 5:30-7:00 pm.
- Canvases are first-come, first-serve. If canvases run out and you would still like to participate, canvases are also available for purchase from Artists Guild.
- **The canvas drop-off deadline is June 21**, and can be dropped off at any distribution point.
- **The unveiling of the mosaic is Friday, July 10, 5:30-7:00 pm.** The mosaic will be on exhibit July 10–August 23, 2026.
- Finished canvases are available for purchase through a blind mailing for \$40 each. Purchases can be made through the duration of the exhibit, and all proceeds benefit the nonprofit organization. Canvases will be mailed out mid-September.
