







# **NFTE Summer Virtual Entrepreneurship Camp**

Middle and high school students are invited to apply for a two-week NFTE Summer Virtual Entrepreneurship Camp where participants will **learn how to start their very own business!** This program is **free** of charge thanks to the Network for Teaching Entrepreneurship (NFTE) and Broward County Public Schools CTACE Department. Spots are limited, and students must have online access.

This summer program is designed to unlock the entrepreneurial mindset as each participant builds a full plan for an original business idea of their own also featuring themes of leadership by leveraging inspirational entrepreneurs as guest speakers and activities focused on confidence- building. Youth will gain the confidence and skills they need to become the CEOs of their future.

The experiential entrepreneurship program activities include group work, individual learning, and a business plan expo. The young entrepreneurs will practice problem-solving, flexibility, collaboration, critical thinking, comfort with risk, and other 21<sup>st</sup> Century workforce development skills. Participants will receive a stipend for participation in the program's entirety and engagement in the camp.
