### PFIZER COVID-19 VACCINE AVAILABLE FOR 12 AND OLDER AT DOH-BROWARD SITES

**Fort Lauderdale, Fla** – Beginning today, May 13, all DOH-Broward vaccination sites will provide the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine to individuals ages 12 and older. On May 12, 2021, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) adopted a recommendation from the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) endorsing the safety and effectiveness of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine and its use in individuals [12 years of age and older](#).

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration expanded the emergency use authorization (EUA) for the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine to include those ages 12 through 15. This EUA was previously issued in December for administration in those 16 years of age and older.

“The expansion of age groups eligible to receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine allows us to protect our adolescents against COVID-19 and therefore better protect our whole community. The vaccine is safe and effective in both adults and adolescents. DOH-Broward is pleased to offer the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine to individuals 12 and older at no cost and without an appointment at all of our fixed and pop-up community vaccination sites.” said Florida Department of Health in Broward County’s Health Officer, Dr. Paula Thaqi said. “This is an important step towards ending the pandemic.”

DOH-Broward, in partnership with Broward County, Broward County Sheriff’s Office, municipalities, municipal law enforcement and Fire Rescue/EMS, operates nine fixed public vaccination sites.
