Look at what we've done as a community...

This spring we can proudly look back on the nearly \$23,000.00 that has been contributed and dedicated to feeding, housing and supporting county residents. What follows is a list and brief description of these caring organizations and the work they do.

The Bridge Fund of Westchester

The only homelessness prevention program to provide emergency rent assistance throughout the year.

Caring for the Homeless in Peekskill

Seeks to alleviate hunger and homelessness in the Peekskill community by providing food and shelter to persons in need.

CLUSTER, INC. (summer camp)

This is Westchester's only program providing a summer day camp experience for children of low-income and homeless families.

Ecumenical Emergency Food Pantry

The Pantry distributes nonperishable foods to hundreds of needy families and individuals in our community.

Family YMCA of Yonkers

In December the Yonkers YMCA finalized its plan for providing dinners and showers each Sunday for The Sharing Community. TIC's donation kick-started this process and we continue to support this important initiative.

Hope Community Services

We are proud to generously support a new initiative by HOPE; HOPE-FUL KIDS, a program to provide meals for Westchester children in need during school breaks like the summer months ahead.

My Sister's Place

The only shelter in lower Westchester for women and their children who have left abusive home situations. Our donation will provide supportive services for women and children as they make the transition from shelter to independent living.

Westchester Jewish Community Services

We earmarked our gift for home delivery of kosher meals to the elderly
