On January 23, the City Council will receive a presentation on the FEMA public assistance process which outlines how the City plans to rebuild city-owned property damaged by the storm. On February 13 and 14, the Council will hold its annual retreat to set priorities for the next year's budget. Hurricane recovery efforts will be a major focus, including discussions on allocating resources for critical relief and rebuilding initiatives. This retreat is an opportunity for Council members to align on long-term strategies to build back stronger and prepare for future challenges.
