This week our congregation is having our annual Vacation Bible School. Maybe we could find a few people in our congregation who might have some teaching talents to help me share a Bible story in church. I recently acquired a bunch of costumes from another congregation which used them years ago in a “living pictures” drama where they acted out the Lord’s Supper. We could have someone dress as one of the characters and share the story for the day! We even have women’s costumes! Are YOU one that has some talents to share in this way? It would be yet another way we can live out our baptismal promises to teach the good news of Jesus Christ!
