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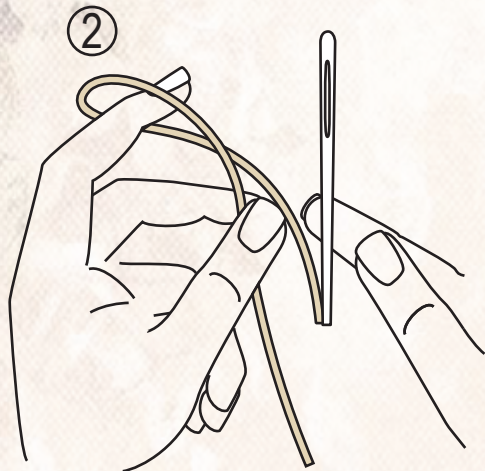


Drizzle Stitch

The Drizzle Stitch is used in Brazilian embroidery. It is recommended to work this stitch in an embroidery hoop and to use a Milliners needle.

1. Bring the needle and thread to the front at A. From the right side, take the tip of the needle partially back down into the fabric close to A, sticking it into a pincushion underneath the fabric. Unthread the needle.

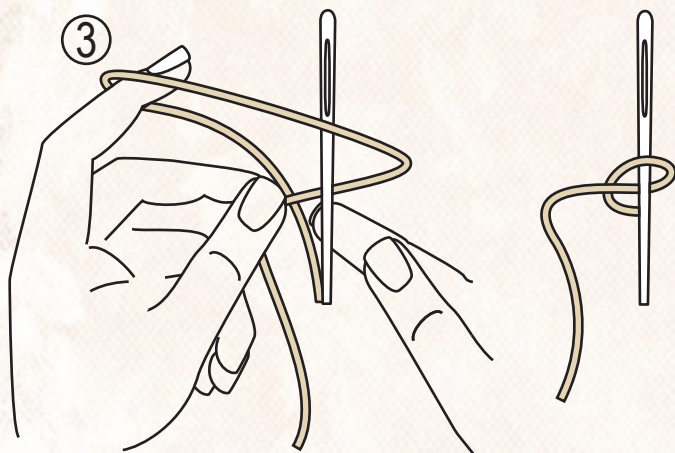
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2. Hold the needle with your right hand. With your left hand, bring the working thread around your index finger to form a loop.

3. Place the loop on the needle, remove your index finger, and pull the loop onto the needle making one Cast-on Stitch.

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4. Work as many Cast-on Stitches as desired. Then rethread the needle. Holding the Cast-on Stitches, tace the thread-needle to the back and secure.

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
