Rabbi Search Committee

After a 2 year search, the Rabbi Search Committee (RSC) made a motion at the March 23, 2020 Board Meeting via Zoom to recommend Rabbi John Carrier as PJTC's permanent Rabbi. The board unanimously accepted the RSC's recommendation and contract negotiations have begun.

From the very beginning, it was very important to the RSC that we would not limit our time to search. We were all very committed to serving the lengthy sentence to continue our search until we found the right fit for our community. We had deep discussions on the role of the rabbi, what our community needs

are, and how our next rabbi could perform those roles in meeting our community needs. We cast our net wide to search worldwide and then through the Rabbinical Assembly.

We want to thank Susan Auerbach, Meredith Rose, Hadar Cohen, Jill Spector, John Guest, Phil Callahan, Jesse Duker, Joe Johnson, Jan Pais, ex-officio members Geoff DeBoskey, Beryl Straus, Cantor Ruth Berman Harris, and Jacob Levy, Ruth Several, and Jeff Landau (ex-officio) who served on the 2018-2019 RSC.

We welcome Rabbi Carrier and look forward to working with him on a permanent, full-time basis.

Board Report

The Board of Directors met on March 23 via Zoom and unanimously approved the Rabbi Search Committee's recommendation to hire Rabbi John Carrier as PJTC's permanent rabbi. The RSC began meeting in fall 2018 and brought in three candidates in spring 2019. The committee then decided to continue the search through the Rabbinical Assembly and brought in one additional candidate beside Rabbi Carrier. On March 17, the committee met and determined it would recommend to the board that it enter into contract negotiations with Rabbi Carrier.

The Board also heard an update about COVID-19 measures PJTC is undertaking. All Shabbat services will be livestreamed and meetings – including those of affiliate groups such as Sisterhood, Men's Club and others – will be conducted via Zoom. Claire Gorfinkel is spearheading the Membership Assistance Committee's assistance with grocery shopping for those who need it and Melissa Levy is connecting USY teens with families needing childcare.

The Board also adopted a bylaws change to allow for electronic payments and to enable the Executive Director to sign approved recurring and regular checks. Previously, the bylaws stipulated that two members of the Board's Executive Committee sign each check. For reimbursements and other non-recurring bills, the board voted that two signers are still needed on checks in excess of \$2,500.

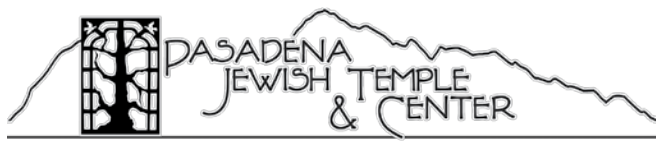
