

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FOLLOW-UP RESULTS⁵

67% Of callers followed up on the referrals.
 46% Of callers who followed up on referrals received the help they needed.
 3% Of callers had scheduled future appointments.
 7% Of callers did not receive the help they needed due to the referred agencies' lack of funds.
