# How to Apply for the Expansion and Emerging Child Care Grant Early Childhood Council of Weld County

#### Go to Coloradoshines.com

- ➤ Open the OEC Portal
- ➤ Login with the ATS or QRIS user name and Password or register as a new user
- ➤ There is a button "Available Grants"
- Enter your license number/provisional license number for those opening new program
- > Complete all fields within the application

## **Specific parts of the application:**

- ➤ If you rent your space, a letter of support from the landlord is required for upload into the application
- > You must submit a Budget:
  - ➤ The Budget template is provided within the application. Download template and complete, then upload into the application.
  - ➤ You may want to contact the Early Childhood Council or Licensing Specialist for support if you have questions
  - > This budget can be amended after grant has been applied for

## Allowable Expenses on the Budget:

- All Expenses must have a justification to explain how the proposed project will assist with increasing the number of child care slots for children in your program.
- ➤ The categories of the project are:
  - Coaching
  - Professional Development
  - ➤ Learning/Classroom Materials
  - > Capitol Improvements
    - ➤ Applications that include Capitol Improvements are required to provide 3 bids for work from bonded and insured contractors for each project applied for

### **Requirements of the Grant:**

- Emerging Programs must earn a Level 2 in the QRIS within 12 months of receiving your permanent license, commit to submitting a complete application for a CCCAP fiscal agreement AND indicate acceptance of a CCCAP child through your program profile on your ColoradoShines.com website
- Expanding Programs must earn a minimal of a Level 2 QRIS within 12 months of the grant award, or by June 30, commit to submitting a complete application for a CCCAP fiscal agreement AND indicate acceptance of a CCCAP child through your program profile on your ColoradoShines.com website
