FACE TO FACE (Traditional)

Self Service Carolina Code
TRAD

Course that is taught in a traditional face-to-face classroom setting.

Example: Course meets in-person on Tuesday and Thursday in a classroom on campus.

BLENDDED/HYBRID (Up to 49% web)

Self Service Carolina Code
B3WEB

Course that is taught both face-to-face and online. 49% or less of the course is online.

Example: Course meets in-person on Monday and Wednesday and online on Friday with synchronous instruction.

Monday, Wednesday, 1:10 – 2:00 pm, DMSB 122
Friday, 1:10 – 2:00 pm, WEB COLUMBIA

BLENDDED (50% or more web)

BWEB

Course that is taught both face-to-face and online. 50% or more of the course is online.

***Example:** Course meets in-person on Monday and online in an asynchronous instructional format with the majority of activities/assignments completed online and due at specific times.*

100% WEB ASYNCHRONOUS

Course that is taught 100% online.
Students complete activities &
assignments on their own time to
meet course deadlines.

*Example: Students are provided assignments
that must be completed by an established due
date.*

100% WEB SYNCHRONOUS

DWEBS

Course that is taught 100% online. Students are required to participate in online meetings/lectures at specific days and times.

Example: Course meets online on Tuesday and Thursday.

100% WEB MIX ASYNCHRONOUS & SYNCHRONOUS

Course that is taught 100% online. Students are required to participate in online meetings/lectures at specific days and times and also complete activities & assignments on their own time to meet course deadlines.

***Example:** Course meets online on Monday and students have additional activities to complete on their own time by a specific due date.*

NOTES FOR FALL 2020

INSTRUCTIONAL METHODS

- Courses with more than 100 students will not be allowed to meet face-to-face.
- Course meeting times must stay the same as when students originally enrolled. Courses moving to an online format will either be scheduled at the same time or for asynchronous instruction.
- If instructional method is changed, all currently enrolled students will be removed from the course for the instructional method to be updated in the system (Banner) and then all students will be re-enrolled in the course. This change will later be documented on the record of all enrolled students.
- Instructors are encouraged to contact students prior to the first day of class to provide instruction on the specifics of the class schedule.
