NOTICE TO PLAYERS

BELOW IS THE LIVE SCORE LOGIN INFO ; Keep Updated During the Round!

If you have any issue on the golf course, please text a Tour Director ; Please make sure to tell me who you are when you send me a text. Ruling Questions, PLAY TWO BALLS, take a photo of the Rule in

Question on the course.

- USGA Rules are always in effect. If you are uncertain of a ruling, play 2 balls and write the score down for each. A determination of the rule will be made by the Tour Director and Head Pro at the end of play.
- 3 Minute Ball Search In Play - Play a Provisional ball whenever in doubt.
- Putts must be holed out completely! Even if the flag stick knocks the ball out. Pins may be removed.
- Playing Conditions: Announced before the Shotgun Start
- Sand Traps/Bunkers: Listen for Morning Announcements on any Bunker Rules, if none you play them Down.
- Remember to review the rules when you visit another Amateur Tour, they may not allow the same relief.
- All players must SIGN the Official Scorecard after the round and bring to the scoring area for approval.
- DAILY FORMATS: Front Nine - Holes 1-9 = Four Ball ; Players will play own ball and record scores on scorecard and SCROLF. Back Nine - Holes 10-18 = Modified Alternate ; Players will Play Tee Ball and Select the best ball and alternate from that ball until the Hole is finished.

DROP ZONES (BALL DROP)- As an option, drop area (Forward Tee Box) are provided on Par 3's with water for balls entering lateral water hazards from teeing areas. A one stroke penalty applies if this option is used.

STONES IN BUNKERS- Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

WASTE AREAS- If any, noted prior to the start of play.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR - is defined by white lines. Fire ant hills and french drains are ground under repair. White-lined areas tying into cart paths are part of those obstructions. Sod seams (not the sod itself) are deemed to be ground under repair, and relief is available under Rule 25-1 if the ball lies in or touches a sod seam or the sod seam interferes with the area of intended swing. All seams within the sodded area are considered the same seam.

Embedded Ball: General Area, a ball that is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground may be lifted, without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course within the General Area.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR AND SODDED AREAS- Defined by white lines. White-lined areas tying into cart paths are part of those obstructions.

Director & RULES COMMITTEE- Tour Director official-in-charge has final authority on any rulings.

DOUBLE PAR MAX SCORE – NO GIMMIES

Tournament Rules:

If it's not in this weeks rules, then don't assume it's allowed just because we had it once before. Players should listen to the announcements before the tournament begins.
