Dear Roosters Community,

As we reflect on the past quarter, I'm pleased to report that we've navigated it successfully and are looking ahead with enthusiasm. Our September lunch at Antonello's was a great success, and due to the positive response, we've decided to return there for our October Vote of our Board Members. Your participation in the upcoming October luncheon is crucial as we select the most qualified candidates to lead our organization.

I'm thrilled to welcome two new members, Barbara Foster and Davi Wilson, to our Roosters family. With three potential members in the pipeline, our membership is steadily growing and will soon reach 55. However, our goal is to reach 60 members by year-end, and we need your help to achieve this. This service will enhance our ability to engage with all members and ensure a 100% response rate. The expected monthly cost for this program is approximately \$25, a worthwhile investment in enhancing our communication.

Last month, we sought your input on alternating between lunches and dinners for our gatherings, and most of you expressed interest in this idea. Now, we're eager to hear your thoughts on two additional matters:

- 2. Meeting Venue Preferences: Would you prefer a quality café meeting which will cost around \$35 per person, or





Twenty one members enjoyed a delicious meal and conversation in the private dining room.




After introductions and monthly meeting updates, our very own Rooster, Marty Burbank, spoke about estate planning, philanthropy and The Roosters Endowment Fund.

#### MENU Selection Format & Hierarchy

#### **Format**

In order of hierarchy\*, each "Table Captain" will be *emailed 1* week prior to the event, to choose the menu for their table. Table Captain will have a 2-hour time limit to make a menu selection. The chef preparing the menu chosen will not be known to the guests until they enter the ballroom which adds to the excitement of the evening!



#### \*Levels of Hierarchy -

Platinum, Gold, Silver, then other tables.

NOTE: Within each level, menu selection priority status is established on the date when the table is paid-in-full.

#### \*Hierarchy

- 1) **Platinum Sponsors** receive <u>first choice for menu</u> selection, and are seated closest to the stage area.
- 2) **Gold Sponsors** receive <u>2<sup>nd</sup> choice</u> for menu selection, by order of date sponsorship was paid in full.
- Silver Sponsors will begin menu selection <u>after</u> the Gold Sponsors have chosen, in paid in full order.
- After the Table Sponsors have chosen their menus, other tables will have opportunity for menu selection.

NOTE: Entry into the Menu Picking Order is established when a table of 12 is "Paid in Full" and thus will move above in picking order, any partially paid tables (at the same level).






