



Dear Seed Survivor Presenter Applicant:

We are delighted that you are interested in being a presenter for the Fall 2022 Seed Survivor Mobile Classroom tour in Colorado. Seed Survivor, developed and sponsored by Nutrien, Ltd., is a free, curriculum-based learning experience that encourages students in Grades 3-5 to master the elements that plants need to grow. The mobile classroom is a truck and 36-foot handicap accessible trailer unit that arrives at pre-registered schools. Students explore multi-media and virtual reality games, a sunflower microgreen planting station, talking walls, and much more. Students leave with an understanding that plants need water, light, healthy soil, and nutrients to survive. They also learn that plants are essential for human survival by producing food, income, oxygen, and enjoyment for us all.

The Colorado Agriculture in the Classroom program will be touring two Seed Survivor Mobile Classrooms in Colorado this school year from September 6th through October 21st. Two presenters are needed for each trailer. One person to present a guided plant lesson outside and facilitate the outside displays. The other person assists participants inside the trailers. Presenters are welcome to rotate throughout the day. Approximately 30 students, divided into two groups, can participate in the display at one time and it takes one hour to complete (30 minutes inside and 30 minutes outside).

Presenters will be compensated for their time at a rate of \$20.00 per hour and are expected to work 4-6 hours per day, depending on how many classrooms have been scheduled for that day. For shifts longer than four hours, a \$15 meal honorarium will be provided. Presenters may also be reimbursed for pre-approved expenses such as mileage at a rate of \$0.625/mile if driving more than one hour from your home, and hotels and meals if overnight travel is needed.

The tour locations and dates are listed in the chart below. The mobile unit can travel within an hour driving distance of each city. The more days each presenter can cover per region the better. Ideally, we are seeking 2-4 presenters per region who can staff the trailer the entire time it is in that region. However, we understand schedules and are flexible, but would ask that each presenter is available to staff the trailer for the entire day. (We anticipate needing roughly 30 presenters in total to ensure both trailers are fully staff throughout the tour.)

- Presenters will need to comply with any school district requirements for Covid-19 and school visitor/volunteer conditions (some districts may require completion of additional forms and potentially background checks).
- Once accepted, presenters are hired as independent contractors of the Colorado Foundation for Agriculture and will adhere to the following:
 - o Sign a contract as a Seed Survivor Program Contractor.
 - o Prepare and submit time sheets and expenses within two weeks of event completion.
 - Be responsible for any federal, state, and local taxes derived from Seed Survivor Program
 Contractor net income (CFA will issue 1099 tax forms for individuals earning \$600 or more).
