Despite the hardships, our commitment to providing safe, affordable housing never wavered. Last year, we proudly supported over **2,000 households** through affordable rentals, essential home repairs, new home construction, and down payment assistance.

## Homeownership Program

Homeownership operates two programs, **turn-key market homes** and **self-help built homes**.

- Sold **2 turn-key homes** on the market.
- Completed **4 new turn-key homes** that are on the market.
- Managed construction of the final **6 self-help homes** in Candler called Spring Garden, which are scheduled to be completed in March 2025.
- Cultivated a planning pipeline for **120 new homeownership units** over the next few years.

## MHO Loan Fund and Down-Payment Assistance (DPA)

The MHO Loan Fund experienced a transition year by adding staff capacity through a **new Loan Fund Officer**, and planning for the future by cultivating partnerships across our region. Additionally, we were able to **close 10 loans for brand-new homeowners!**

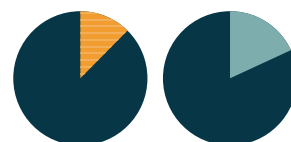
MHO served **2,371 residents** across **1,426 units** in **28 properties**. These numbers include...
