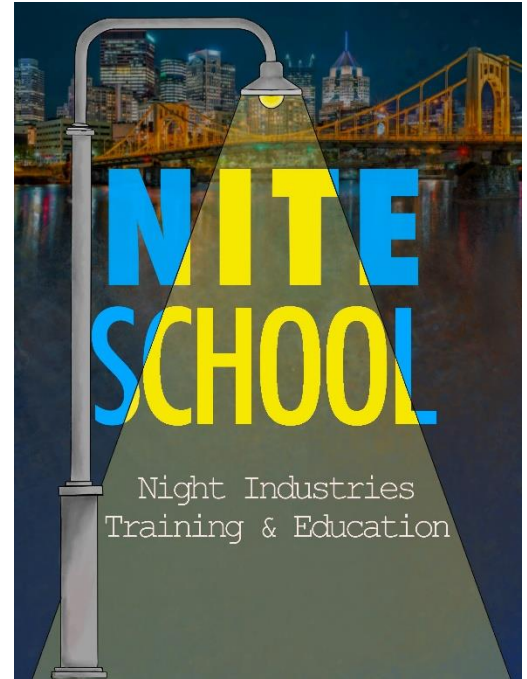


OFFICE OF NIGHTTIME ECONOMY
