SPRING 2021 HYBRID INSTRUCTION PLAN

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Student social distancing at school as much as possible, including space seating and / or sneeze guards
- New hand sanitizer pumps have been installed inside each classroom door
- Each classroom will be assigned 1 quadrant of the gym (facilitates contact tracing)
- Masks required for students and teachers
- Teachers may replace mask with face shield only if giving a lesson that requires students to see the teacher's facial expressions or mouth for guidance in pronunciation
- Increased instruction about handwashing and avoiding contact with the face
- Students will only use the bathrooms in the ladies hallway
- Students will be limited to two students per bathroom, using every other faucet
- Classroom surfaces will be disinfected daily by school staff
- Building will be cleaned daily after Fajr
- No lunch at school (one small snack in classrooms)
- Classroom materials – where possible students will continue using their own toolkits
- Classroom materials that are shared will be rotated and disinfected
- Public access will be limited to the Men's Prayer Hall during and after school hours
- Only school staff, students and cleaning crew will have access to the classrooms

CLASSES (HYBRID IN-PERSON)

Pre-K

- Monday – Thursday Onsite
- Timings 8:15am to 12:35pm
- Art will remain as a video link on Fridays
- Pre-K J and Pre-K Z will be merged in one classroom.
- Ms. Jabeen and Ms. Zoya will continue to teach as co-teachers
- Ms. Farah will continue to be the TA
- Quran classes will remain online but will be scheduled during in-person hours
- Classroom assignments will continue to be posted on Seesaw

- 8:15 – 12:35 On site: Math, Language, Science, SEL, PE and Islamic Studies
- 1:15 – 3:30 Online: Quran Reading and Quran Memorization (small groups)
- Ms. Farzana's Islamic Studies class will remain online, but during school hours
- Art will remain a seesaw video link on Fridays
- Teachers and TA's will remain the same
- Classroom assignments will continue to be posted on Seesaw

REMOTE STUDENTS

- Webex sessions will continue using the same classroom link
- Online students will join the class via Webex with the TA managing the camera
- Teachers and students will be able to interact with online students during group lessons
- A new schedule for online students will be provided, which will include group lesson timings and times when they can take a break from the screen to work on their assignments or rest
- Online students should keep the camera on during school timings.
- Assignments will continue to be posted on Seesaw for all students (in-person and online)
- Toolkits will be provided

POLICY

- Students who have not completed the immunizations normally required by the state must remain online (you will be notified if this is the case with your child)
- Pick up and drop off will be from outside the building via the carpool lane
- Daily self-certification required (whether manual or via app)
- Students with temperature of 99.9 or above will be sent home
- Student who are coughing, sneezing, or have runny noses will be asked to stay home, or will be sent home
- Students with allergies that cause them sneeze or cough will be required to provide a doctor's note before beginning hybrid instruction
- Students who refuse to wear a mask or are not able to wear a mask the whole time must remain online
- If a student has come in contact with a household member or visitor who tested positive for COVID-19, that student must return to online learning for 10 calendar days
- If a student or teacher tests positive for COVID-19 all students and teachers in that class will return to online learning for 10 calendar days. A special teacher who came into

close contact with a COVID-19 positive student or teacher would also have to teach online for all grades for 10 calendar days

- If the Ogden building is closed due to a confirmed COVID case, or a rise in overall cases in the community, all students and teachers will return to online learning until the board has cleared us for return (this could be a day or two, or more)

LIMITATIONS and RISKS

- ICN buildings, including Ogden will continue to be open for daily salah and Jumu'ah
- Bathroom usage will be restricted but there is no guarantee that the men's bathrooms will not be used by musallis or masjid guests
- ICN will allow ICN clubs and groups to use the Ogden building (excluding the classrooms) for meeting or events (no food allowed)
- It is likely that ICN will have in-person Taraweeh in a limited capacity during Ramadan, during which the men's and women's prayer halls, gym, and west wing will be used (daily cleaning after Fajr will continue)
- ICN Noor Academy teachers and staff have all registered for COVID-19 vaccination with DuPage County as well as the county of residence, however not all have been given appointments yet. Edward Elmhurst has placed our school on their list of institutions to schedule for vaccinations, however, this process is currently very slow, and we are seeking to partner with any other clinics or hospitals that we can. Most staff members have not yet received the first dose of the vaccine.
