

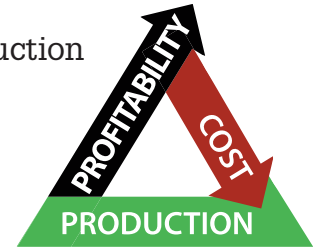


MAXIMIZE PROFITS AND MINIMIZE CHAOS
