I want to share information with you on an exciting new website where you can find over 6,000 books and daily news articles to help keep you reading! This is so helpful now that libraries are closed and you may be running out of books at home.

This site is very easy to navigate and offers books on a wide range of topics, grade and reading levels, and even length of book. You can read the book or have the book read to you. An added bonus is that the majority of books on this site have AR quizzes! So, if you are in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, or are a member of the AR club (3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> graders), you can read a book, visit the AR website, take the quiz and earn points.

When you hover over a book, you can select the green “read” tab to start reading the book or the blue “info” tab to learn more about the recommended grade level, length of the book, etc. After clicking the info tab, select the blue “i” tab at the top . . . this will give the ATOS level, AR quiz #, points, etc. When a student reads a book, if they want to take the AR quiz, they should look at the “i” tab first and note the AR quiz number so they can use that quiz number to find the book in AR.

Since AR can be used to take quizzes on most of the books from this myON site, here is the link to AR:
