Projects and Events

- **Lumber Milling**
We will be milling Douglas-fir lumber in 2x6 and 2x8 dimension plus making some large cuts for benches.
- **Schick Property, Tree Limb Remove @ New Entrance (still meet at Hopkins 8:30am)**
A part of the CFD crew will head over to the Schink Demonstration Forest (3 miles out of Molalla) to limb up the trees along Dickey Prairie Road to improve site distance at the new entrance.

All projects/gatherings will be practicing social distancing and please bring your own mask, protective gear, water, and snacks.
