



For All Ordering Providers and Nurses
DKA 2 Bag Order Set Now Available at All Hospital Locations
Effective Monday, Aug. 17

On Monday, Aug. 17, the **DKA 2 Bag** order set will be available for ordering providers at all hospital locations, helping patients receive care more quickly.

Providers:

- This is a restricted order set, for ordering providers only.
- Nurses will receive a BPA alert when the order set is placed.
 - Only specially trained nurses can carry out these orders.
- If the patient is no longer on the **DKA Bag 2** system, the issuing provider must discontinue the order below.

DKA orderset to be acted on by trained nurse only
Routine, Until discontinued, Starting today at 1402, Until Specified
If the patient is no longer on the DKA 2 Bag System, this order must be discontinued to stop the nursing BPA alert.

Nurses:

- When the order set is placed, this BPA will display when you open the chart.

Critical (1)

A 2 Bag DKA orderset has been ordered for this patient. This is a very technical orderset for treatment of acutely/critically ill patients. If you have not been specifically trained in the use of this orderset, be sure to alert your leadership to get an ICU/IMU trained staff or NP to assist with the initiation of the orders and continued monitoring. You may consider a CERT/RRT call to obtain the support you need.

Acknowledge Reason

I am an appropriately trained nurse Contacted a trained nurse for assistance

Accept

- Select the appropriate **Acknowledge Reason**.
- If you select, **I am an appropriately trained nurse**, the BPA will not alert you again for that patient.
- If **Contacted a trained nurse for assistance** is selected, you will receive another alert in 12 hours.

- If you are not specifically trained for this order set, the issuing provider must discontinue the order to stop the BPA alert using the **DKA order set to be acted on by a trained nurse** order.
