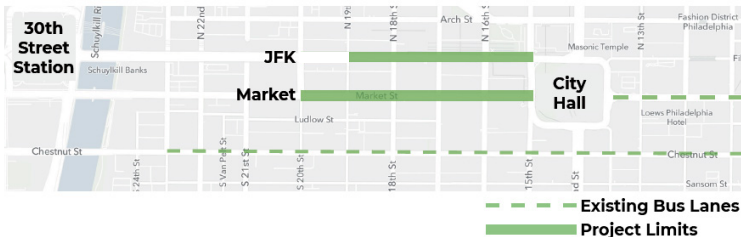

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE



What Does This Project include?

This project will install bus-only lanes on Market Street (15th to 20th), and JFK Blvd. (15th to 19th) as part of an 18-month pilot.

When Does Work Begin?

Line striping is expected to begin in August 2021 and is expected to take one month to complete. Construction timing is weather dependent and may change.

Can I Use Market St./JFK Blvd. During Construction?

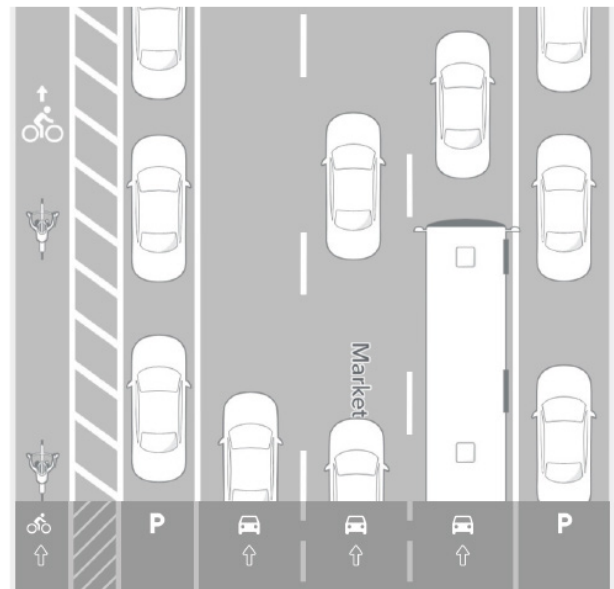
Yes, the streets will remain open for traffic during construction. There will be periodic closures of the right-most travel and parking lanes. The protected bike lanes should not be affected.

Why is This Project Important?

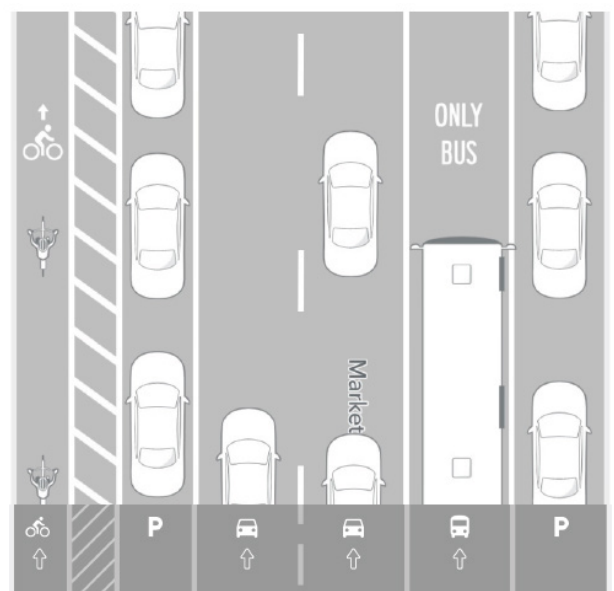
- Roughly half of all users of the two streets are on buses, over 23,000 trips per day on the bus.
- Transit is an affordable and energy efficient method of transportation.
- 13 different bus routes add up to 43 buses per hour during rush hour.
- Prioritizing transit reduces traffic congestion.

After the 18-month pilot, the project will be evaluated for its effects on roadway safety, transit speed and reliability, congestion, and public support.
