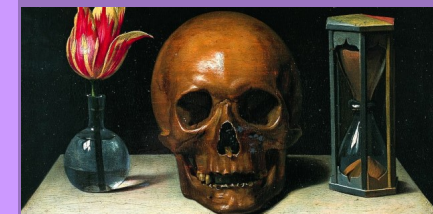
MoAS invites you to **Church Without Walls on March 1st**. We will be carpooling from the church at **12:45pm**.

The first Sunday of Lent, Sunday, March 1st, will begin, as always, with the **Great Litany** at both services, and the return of the **Rite I liturgy for the season during the 8am Holy Eucharist**. This is meant to usher in the quiet, solemn prayer of repentance at the heart of Lenten Season in the church. To walk with Christ this Lent, you are again invited to join the clergy in walking the **Stations of the Cross each Friday at 12:10pm inside the church, beginning March 6th**. This, in addition to everything listed below, is set in place to help deepen your faith and prayer life as we prepare for Holy Week & Easter here at All Saints.

The Men of All Saints will be serving a hot lunch for the homeless at **Church Without Walls on Sunday, March 1st**. If you would like to join us for the worship service and to help with the food, meet at All Saints at **12:45pm** to carpool downtown to the Diocesan Office. The service starts at 1:30pm and we will serve lunch directly after. Join us!

New adult class, "Ascending Benedict's Twelve Steps of Humility" begins Sunday, March 1, at 9:30am in the Parish Hall. During Sunday mornings in Lent, Fr. Donovan will be leading a special class through the 12 steps of humility found in Chapter 7 of the Rule of St. Benedict. The class will focus on this central important action of being both a monk and a Christian, following the ladder of ascent which St. Benedict describes as leading the climber towards the "exaltation of heaven." St. Benedict uses passages from throughout the Bible for each step towards humility, and each Sunday Fr. Donovan will break down those passage and steps to discuss the continued need for humility in our lives today. *Copies of St. Benedict's Rule will be available to purchase for just \$3.*

On Saturday, March 28th, 11am-1pm, come have lunch with Fr. Donovan and plan your funeral! Fr. D will be leading a continuation of his teaching & discussion on the Christian practice of *Memento*

Mori, "Remember your Death," this time focusing on the planning of Christian funeral rites in the Church. One of the greatest gifts you can give your family when the times comes for you to leave this physical world and make your journey to be with God is to have your funeral services planned out, with scripture passages chosen, hymns picked out, and people you'd like to be involved chosen for the services. Join our "Memento Mori" priest for this important Lenten conversation, as you map out your funeral service to be placed on file here in the church office!
