



Indiana Health Coverage Programs Enrollment Trend Highlights – April 2025



IHCP Program Membership:

Total Membership decreased in April. With **1,946,326** members, there were **24,584**, or **1.25%, less** members in April 2025 than in March 2025.


Category Membership:

Membership decreased in February in all five major categories. HIP membership dropped the most, losing 2%, over 15,000, of its members.

Insights:

The chart on the right shows the only subcategories that grew in April. With 1,233 new members, HIP Maternity increased the most and was the only HIP subcategory to experience an increase. Conversely, the HIP State Plan Plus and HIP Regular Plus subcategories lost the most and second most members respectively, combining for nearly 14,000 fewer members in April 2025 than in March 2025.
