IHCP Program Membership:


Total Membership decreased in October. With 1,970,835 members, there were 5,424, or 0.27%, less members in October 2024 than in September 2024.

Category Membership:

HCC and PWA were the only categories that gained members in October. HHW lost the most members with over 4,200 less in October. The membership in HIP decreased by more than 1,200, while FFS membership lowered by 974.

Insights:

The chart to the right has the totals of the subcategories for Maternity, Newborns, and ages 0-1 since October 2023. After experiencing a slight rise in September, membership in these categories dropped sharply, by nearly 15,000, in October. From October 2023 to October 2024, these categories lost almost 42,000 members.



The values above reflect the percentage difference between the previous month, the six-month rolling average, and the same month last year, respectively.
