



# Indiana Health Coverage Programs Enrollment Trend Highlights – May 2024



## IHCP Program Membership:

Total Membership **decreased** in May. With **1,977,147** members, there were **13,675**, or **-0.69%**, fewer members in May 2024 than in April 2024.

The values above reflect the percentage difference between the previous month, the six-month rolling average, and the same month last year, respectively.

Each of the four major IHCP categories lost members in May.

The chart to the right shows the number of uninsured Hoosiers by age and gender. The most recent data is from the [2022 American Community Survey](#). There are more male uninsured in each age range except for 75+. In the 26-34, the age range with the largest difference, there are over 53% more uninsured males than uninsured females.
